

MDUF Research Award - Conditions of Entry

By entering the MDUF Research Award you agree to be bound by these Conditions of Entry. Any application not complying with these Conditions of Entry is invalid.

The Promoter is David Bell, Level 7, 60 Carrington St, Sydney NSW 2000.

1. Eligibility
 - Entry is open to all people over 18 years of age and who are a resident of Australia, working in industry or academically.
 - Employees, immediate family members of employees and employees of any company associated with Mine Wealth + Wellbeing are not eligible to enter.
2. Entry
 - The Promotion commences at 12.01am (AEST) on 31 August 2017 and entries close at 23.59pm (AEST) on 31 August 2018.
 - To enter, eligible entrants must:
 - undertake research using MDUF v1;
 - the research must be presented at a conference (industry or academic); and
 - a presentation and/or paper is to be made available via the MDUF collaboration sites (www.membersdefaultutilityfunction.com.au or [www.aist.asn.au/policy/member%E2%80%99s-default-utility-function-\(mduf\).aspx](http://www.aist.asn.au/policy/member%E2%80%99s-default-utility-function-(mduf).aspx))
 - The research does not need to be supportive of MDUF.
 - David Bell reserves the right to publicly critique the research.
 - Eligible entrants receive one entry to the competition regardless of how many research items they present during the promotion period. David Bell will select what he considers to be the highest quality research piece produced by the entrant when assessing the entry.

3. Prizes and winning
 - Winners will be selected based on merit, by David Bell. Selection criteria include:
 - In the opinion of the reviewer (David Bell) MDUF v1 is used significantly in the research (i.e. not on the periphery).
 - The research is of a high quality with no clear errors.
 - Prizes will be awarded as winners are identified (i.e. there is a first come – first assessed basis).
 - The Promoter reserves the right to not award prizes if there is an insufficient number of high quality entrants (as judged by David Bell).
 - The Promoter reserves the right to announce winners to media forums, with the purpose to attract extra attention to MDUF.
 - Winners will receive \$500 to utilise as they see fit.
 - The total prize pool value is \$2,000 (i.e. a maximum of 4 prizes to be awarded to entries received prior to 31 August 2018),
4. Prize conditions
 - Winners will be notified by phone / email as they are identified.
 - Non-winners will also be notified regarding their non-successful entry.
